Books Donation Campaign

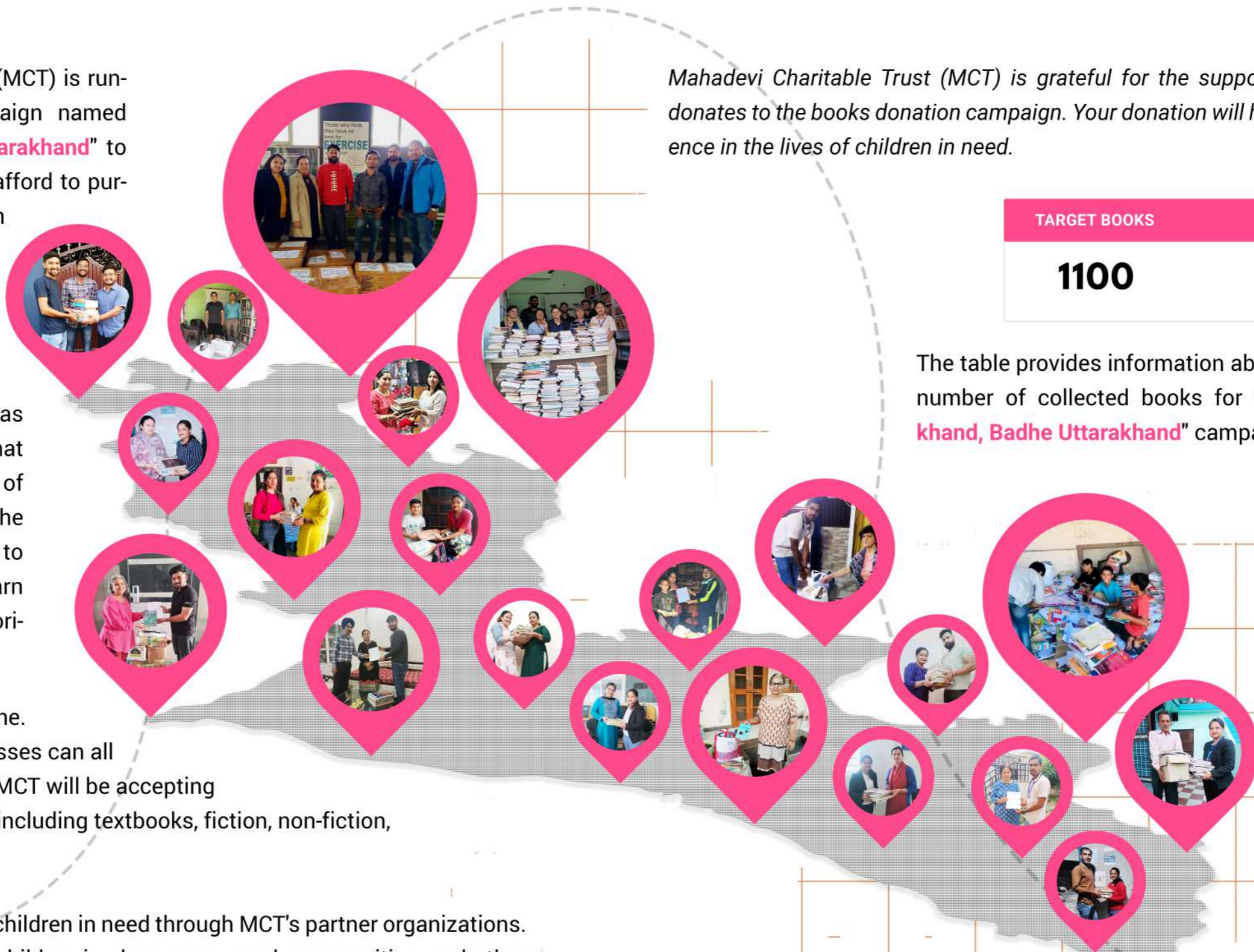

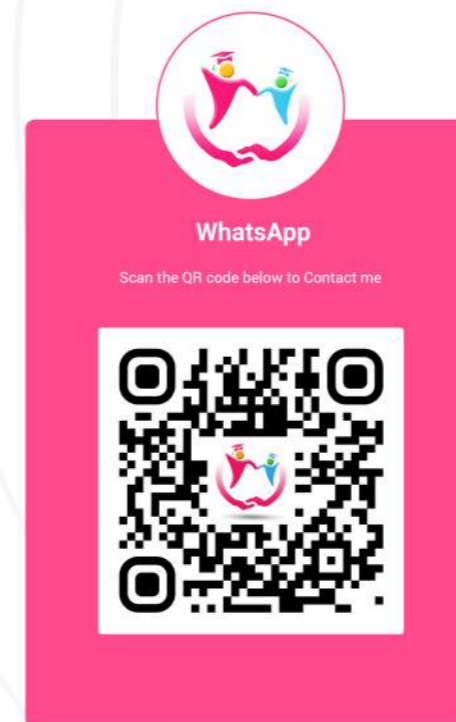
